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Minor Consent To Medical Treatment

The medical consent for the treatment of a minor is a simple but important document that grants authority to a designated adult to care for the child of the signatory in the case of a medical emergency. The authority is temporary, the start and end date will be provided within the document.

In general, minors (individuals under the age of 18 years) require a parent or legal guardian to consent for medical care and treatment. However, there are a few exceptions that allow minors* to provide their own consent for certain types of medical care.

Authority to consent to surgical and medical treatment of certain minors. A. Whenever any minor who has been separated from the custody of his parent or guardian is in need of surgical or medical treatment, authority commensurate with that of a parent in like cases is conferred, for the purpose of giving consent to such surgical or medical treatment, as follows:

§ 54.1-2969. Authority to consent to surgical and medical ...

(b) Consent by a child to medical, dental, psychological, and surgical treatment under this section is not subject to disaffirmance because of minority. (c) Consent of the parents, managing conservator, or guardian of a child is not necessary in order to authorize hospital, medical, surgical, or dental care under this section.

Many states specifically authorize minors to consent to contraceptive services, testing and treatment for HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases, prenatal care and delivery services, treatment for alcohol and drug abuse, and outpatient mental health care.

Minors and the Right to Consent to Health Care ...

Finally, most states allow a minor to consent to evaluation and treatment of specific medical conditions without the consent of a parent, generally including mental health services, treatment for drug and alcohol addiction, pregnancy-related care, contraceptive services, and testing for and treatment of sexually transmitted diseases.

Consent for Emergency Medical Services for Children and ...

Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4 and NRS 449A.551 and 450B.525, the consent of the parent or parents or the legal guardian of a minor is not necessary for a local or state health officer, board of health, licensed physician or public or private hospital to examine or provide treatment for any minor, included within the provisions of subsection 1, who understands the nature and purpose of the proposed examination or treatment and its probable outcome, and voluntarily requests it ...

Missouri Minor onsent Laws

A child's health care providers have a duty to obtain informed consent for treatment of the patient, which involves discussing treatment decisions with parents or guardians. But a "psychiatrist treating a minor child does not have an obligation also to treat the child's parents, or other family.

Children and young people. People aged 16 or over are entitled to consent to their own treatment. This can only be overruled in exceptional circumstances. Like adults, young people (aged 16 or 17) are presumed to have sufficient capacity to decide on their own medical treatment, unless there's significant evidence to suggest otherwise. Children under the age of 16 can consent to their own treatment if they're believed to have

enough intelligence, competence and understanding to fully ...

In those circumstances when a minor may legally authorize the treatment without parental consent (outpatient mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, or venereal disease treatment), then only the minor can consent to the release of the information. 37 Yale Radiation v. MEDICAL TREATMENT OF MINORS - LEGAL GUIDE

Proof of consent must be included in the minor's medical record. Minors may consent to HIV/STD testing and treatment for an STD. Minors may consent to other medical treatment services in certain circumstances, pursuant to Texas Family Code Chapter 32 as outlined below.

MINOR CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT LAWS

(2) A minor may consent to medical care or the administration of medication by a hospital licensed to provide hospital services or by a physician licensed to practice medicine in this state for the purpose of alleviating or reducing pain, discomfort, or distress of and during labor and childbirth. The manner of administration of medications includes but is not limited to intravenous, intramuscular, epidural, and spinal.
